RALLY CLASSES

1. Standard Class. Participants in this class receive the standard Route Instructions and compete against each other for trophies. All participants with more than minimal TSD rally experience are encouraged to enter this class. The degree of difficulty of this class, on a scale of 1 to 10 (with 1 being extremely easy and 10 being extremely difficult), is estimated to be approximately 3-4.

2. Novice Class. Participants in this class receive the novice Route Instructions and compete against each other for trophies. Participants with no or very minimal TSD rally experience are encouraged to enter this class. The degree of difficulty of this class is estimated to be approximately 1-2.

3. Touring Class. Participants in this class receive the touring Route Instructions and do not compete or receive trophies. This class is designed for people who wish only to drive a Rally Route with plain-language instructions, and not be concerned with timing calculations or course-following challenges. This is a follow-the-leader format with a lead car doing the navigation.
